Register Online

Online registration for the Summer Arts program takes place at http://summerarts.bcsd.org. We will process your registration (in the order it is submitted) once we have received your online form and personal check for payment. We do not accept online payments or credit cards at this time.

Registration begins February 9 for Brighton residents and March 2 for non-residents. Registrations must be received by May 1 to ensure enrollment. Registrations received after May 1 will be accepted based upon space availability. Wait lists will be available if shows reach maximum capacity. Class assignments and required forms will be e-mailed in May. Brighton Summer Arts reserves the right to cancel any activity due to insufficient enrollment.

Cancellations & Refunds

Cancellations made on or before May 15, 2015 will receive a full refund. After May 15, you may submit a request in writing to our Camp Director, Mr. Jim Orgar. A \$100 processing fee will be held upon cancellation. Refunds are not issued after June 19.
